

Laide and Aultbea Community Woodland Gift Aid

As a recognised Scottish charity Laide and Aultbea Community Woodland is entitled to claim tax back from the Inland Revenue on any donations received, at no cost to the donor. If you would like us to claim tax back on your donation, please complete the Gift Aid declaration, below.

Guidance Notes

1. You can cancel this declaration at any time by notifying Laide and Aultbea Community Woodland.
2. You must pay an amount of Income Tax/Capital Gains Tax at least equal to the tax that the charity reclaims on your donations in the tax year (currently 28p for each £1 you give).
3. If in the future your circumstances change and you no longer pay tax on your income and capital gains equal to the tax that the charity reclaims, you can cancel your declaration by notifying Laide and Aultbea Community Woodland.
4. If you pay tax at the higher rate, you can claim further tax relief in your Self Assessment tax return.
5. If you are unsure whether your donations qualify for Gift Aid tax relief, ask your local tax office for leaflet IR113 Gift Aid.
6. Please notify Laide and Aultbea Community Woodland if you change your name and address.
